BISI – Indian Breast Imaging Certification

Eligibility criteria

- 1. Training in Radiology the candidate should have completed MD/ DNB in Radio-diagnosis.
- 2. BISI membership The candidate must be a Breast Imaging Society of India member for a minimum of 2 years.
- 3. Subspeciality training: At least two years of subspeciality practice in breast imaging or dedicated breast imaging fellowship training for a period of 1 year is required.
- 4. RIS documentation or logbook:

All candidates must submit a RIS documentation or logbook showing evidence of their breast imaging practice of the last 2 years/ fellowship training for the duration of 1 year. Minimum qualifications required are the following:

- Should have independently reported at least 1000 mammograms per year
- 600 breast ultrasounds per year
- 50 breast MRI studies per year
- Should have independently performed 25 breast interventions per year.

5. Conferences:

- Should have attended a minimum of 2 national conferences(BISICON)
- Should have attended a minimum of 12 BISI webinars/ 10 BISI Webinars and 2 BISI midterm conferences/ BISI outreach programmes.
- BISI mentorship program if attended.

6. Presentations:

• Should have done a minimum of 2 paper/ poster presentations in breast imaging.

7. Letter of support:

- The application must be accompanied by a letter of support from the candidate's Head of the Department. This letter has to confirm that the candidate was trained in breast imaging for a duration of at least two years after their post-graduation (OR)
- Certification of completion of one year of Breast Imaging fellowship training from the Course Director.
